With the concurrence of the Facility Security Committee, including the U.S. Court of

Appeals for the Third Circuit, the Circuit Executive's Office, and the U.S. Marshal, and in

consultation with GSA, it is ORDERED the James A. Byrne U.S. Courthouse in Philadelphia,

Pennsylvania will be closed from noon on Wednesday, March 25, 2020, through Sunday, March

29, 2020. No one will be permitted to enter the building during this closure with the exception of

GSA-authorized cleaning personnel. The Byrne Courthouse will reopen for official business on

Monday, March 30, 2020.

The United States District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania remains open for

official business. The Court's Electronic Case Filing (ECF) system is not affected by the closure,

and parties may continue to file electronically and email documents to the Clerk's Office pursuant

to the Standing Orders and other instructions on the Court's website. The drop box in the lobby

of the Byrne Courthouse will not be available until Monday, March 30, 2020.
